List of Application Materials for International Chinese Language Teachers

Scholarship

I. General Documents (Required for All Applicants)

1. Scanned copy of passport photo page.
2. Scanned copy of HSK and HSKK score reports (valid for two years).
3. Recommendation letter from the head of the Recommending Institution.

II. Additional Documents for Degree Students

4. Proof of highest academic qualification (or proof of expected graduation) and academic transcripts.
5. Doctoral students in International Chinese Language Education must provide two recommendation letters from associate professors or professors or experts with equivalent professional titles in relevant fields. They must provide a personal statement in Chinese (approx. 3,000 words), detailing their understanding of the intended major and their research plan. Priority will be given to applicants who provide an employment agreement (or equivalent proof) from a teaching institution for post-graduation employment.
6. Master's Students in International Chinese Language Education) must provide recommendation letters from two supervisors holding the title of associate professor or above. Priority will be given to applicants who provide an employment agreement (or equivalent proof) from a teaching institution for post-graduation employment.

III. In-service Chinese Language Teachers must attach proof of employment and a recommendation letter issued by their employer.

IV. Applicants under the age of 18 must submit entrusted guardianship documents

signed by a guardian in China.

V. Applicants must also provide any other proof materials required by the Host Institution.
